



Christian Persecuted Rescue (CPR) is an interdenominational team of individuals committed to supporting refugees around the world. Our members are from Angus, Alliston, Utopia, Wasaga Beach, and various other communities in Southern Ontario.

The mission of the Christian Persecuted Rescue is to identify, rescue and sponsor to Canada the most needy of persecuted Christian families. The vision of CPR is 3 phased. **CPRescue** will identify, rescue and stabilize. **CPRailroad** will process their refugee sponsorship to Canada. **CPRelationship** will prepare and welcome them into whole life fellowship in Canada.

CPR has selected a Christian Pakistani family of 4 from Pakistan which fled to Thailand and now is in a desperate situation there. The father was a lay preacher and active in leading public protests against the persecution of Christians by Pakistan's infamous blasphemy laws. CPR plans to keep sponsoring more families on our radar once the full amount is raised for this one. We have personal testimonies of other Christian Pakistani families also trapped in Thailand needing sponsored.

CPR has partnered with the Evangelical Asian Church in Toronto which has personal connections in Bangkok and has extensive experience in identifying the most needy candidates, verifying that they are authentic Christian victims of persecution and navigating the Canadian Sponsorship process.

CPR recognises that many Canadian churches have connections and experience in assisting the persecuted church from various countries and equally desperate situations. We welcome information sharing.
