The Lead Pastor will be a gifted and sound preacher/teacher who can oversee our pulpit ministry and prepare and preach approximately 34 Sundays throughout each year. The successful candidate will be able to inspire the Auburn family to live out our vision and cultivate a missional mindset.

We recognize that the role of Pastor does not neatly fit into a 9-5 world and yet value a balanced approach to ministry which allows protection of family and personal time. It is estimated that the ministry requirements will average approximately 40 hours per week.
